Anticipated Ammo Requirements:

Main Match: 100 Pistol Cartridges -100 Rifle Cartridges, Pistol Caliber - 50 Shotgun Shells (7 ½ or smaller). Although we are **not** declaring this a "lost brass" match, we will be running the posses efficiently. Therefore, you will get what brass can be retrieved in a reasonable time in order to keep the posses running on schedule.

Wild Bunch: Five+ magazines, 50 Pistol, 20 Rifle and 12 Shotgun (bring extra ammo in the event a 3rd stage is shot). *Current Wild Bunch rules apply. See SASS web site*.

Side Matches: Side matches will be shot on Friday with awards given out at the Saturday night banquet. The *side matches* on Friday are listed below. The two-stage <u>Wild Bunch side match will be shot on Saturday afternoon</u> after lunch. See *Schedule of Events* for times of side matches.

Take I-10 to Exit 182 (Hwy 22, Sorrento, Sunshine Bridge).

Go South on Hwy 22 to the caution light, approx. ¹/₄ mile.

Turn left on to Hwy 70, proceed for 3 miles.

As you approach the 3 miles, you will see some heavy power lines crossing the highway. Start slowing down.

On the left there is an old white house and an abandon house trailer.

TURN LEFT; go through the gate to the range.

If you pass under the power lines, you have gone too far.
